Students who graduate from this program can work in many different institutions. Psychology undergraduate graduates work in institutions affiliated with the Ministry of Health, institutions affiliated with the Ministry of Family, Labor and Social Services, schools, guidance-psychological counseling centers, special education centers, kindergartens, nursing homes, private teaching institutions, mental health units, and institutions related to sports psychology. They are employed in the human resources departments of the private sector, and in the health and psychological counseling departments or units of military and police units.
